## **Three Eagles Communications and Kids Against Hunger Launch Relief Effort for Haiti**

Madison East Center donates 5,600 sq ft space for Relief Effort

**Mankato, MN, January 13, 2010:** Three Eagles Communications radio stations **Country 103.5, Z-99, 105.5 The River, and 95.7 The Blaze** are joining forces with **Kids Against Hunger** to raise funds and bag meals for earthquake victims in Haiti. Tuesday's earthquake left 4 to 5 million Haitians in need of immediate basic necessities. This disaster only served to intensify the existing poverty felt by more than 10,000,000 Haitians due to third world conditions. **Kids Against Hunger** nationwide has launched an effort to raise \$207,000,000 towards food to feed Haiti for 3 months. 2 million meals are needed immediately with many millions more needed in the days ahead.

Madison East Center has donated 5,600 square feet of retail space next to the main entrance, where donations will be accepted, and volunteers will work together to bag meals Thursday, Friday and Saturday.

Three Eagles Communications radio personalities will broadcast live on all 4 Three Eagles radio stations, **Country 103.5, Z-99, 105.5 The River, and 95.7 The Blaze** from Thursday until Saturday to raise local awareness, encouraging local families and community groups to volunteer their time and money to support this emergency relief effort.
