Within the last three months, the New Hope (MN) Headquarters and the Mankato (MN) Division of Kids Against Hunger have distributed food as follows:

- 855,360 meals to Haiti
- 106,920 meals to Tanzania
- 42,768 meals to Liberia
- 13,608 meals within the USA

We would like to thank all our volunteers and financial contributors who made it possible for us to provide those meals to families in need!

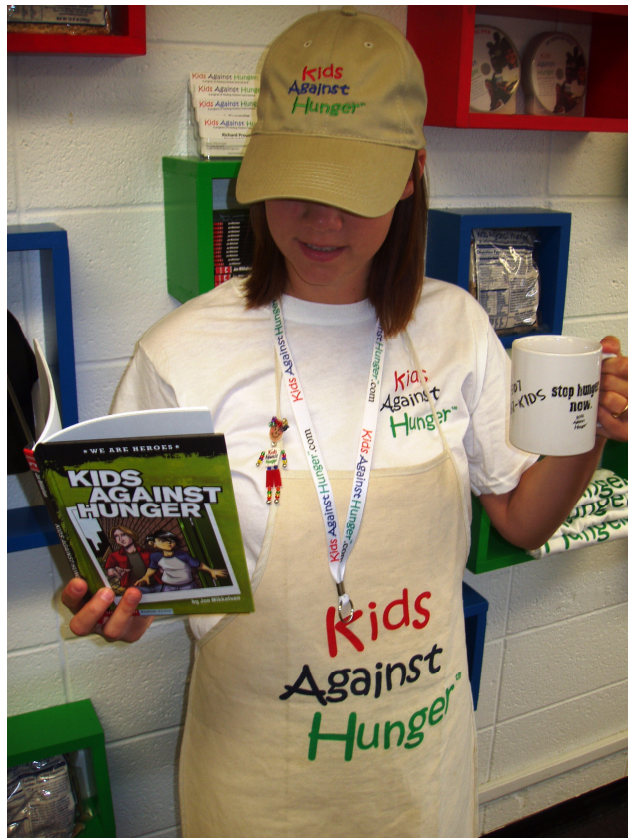

## Participating in Combined Federal Campaign



For more than four decades, the U.S. government has sponsored the Combined Federal Campaign - the world's largest workplace fundraising drive.

Each fall, beginning in September, federal employees - civilian, military and postal - are invited to support eligible national and local charities.

Employees choose the groups they wish to support from a list of charities that have submitted applications and been deemed qualified by the CFC. About 1.3 million employees pledge over a quarter billion dollars each year. Over a third of the federal workforce participates in the CFC each year, with the average pledge exceeding \$170.
