Rotary Convention a Great Success

Representatives from two Rotary Club-sponsored Kids Against Hunger satellites and Headquarters attended the International Rotary Convention in New Orleans. We probably saw all 17,000 attendees at least once! Rotarians from 30 different countries visited our booth just the first day! They included Uganda, India, Thailand, Japan, France, Nepal, Denmark, South Africa, Korea, and Brazil.

Meal Distribution in Pakistan



Through Kids Against Hunger's partnership with Operation Blessing, a full truck load of food (285,120 meals) which left our Mankato (MN) warehouse in April just arrived in Pakistan where it will be used to feed homeless and hungry families who so desperately need good nutrition.

Response to Tornadoes

This weekend, we are packaging meals with Medtronic and other groups to send a container of food (285,120 meals) to the Pentecostal Church of God in Joplin to support the feeding program through August. We are also adding more packaging sessions at our New Hope (MN) office this month to fill a second container to be distributed by Convoy Of Hope in Joplin over the next few months.



As we wrapped up our booth at the International Rotary Convention in new Orleans on May 26th, we sent our excess meals with a group that was heading from New Orleans to Joplin.

Kids Against Hunger - Omaha (NE) has already distributed 50,000 meals in Joplin. Kids Against Hunger - Tulsa (OK) sent 13,000 meals to Joplin this week. Kids Against Hunger - Tavares (FL) also helped out by sending 17,000 meals to Oxford (AL), another town affected by the tornado.

On May 28th, Kids Against Hunger's Scott Anderson also delivered 28,000 meals to tornado victims in North Minneapolis.

Recent Food Shipments

In May, our nutritious rice-soy casserole was shipped to the following countries from our New Hope and Mankato (MN)

dozens of Rotary Clubs from other countries, countries that need our food. These international Rotary Clubs may be able to develop relationships with U.S.-based Kids Against Hunger satellites to receive food for their countries. Rotary member Tracylyn Sharrit (pictured above in the white sweater) is one such avenue. Her club has built a relationship with a Ugandan Rotary Club.
